I. POLICY STATEMENT

The Minnesota State Board of Civil Legal Aid (BOCLA) is an independent judicial branch agency charged with ensuring access to high-quality civil legal services in every Minnesota county. BOCLA's work shall be overseen by the members of the Minnesota State Board of Civil Legal Aid through the establishment and monitoring of administrative policies designed to support access to high-quality civil legal aid in every Minnesota county and to ensure that BOCLA functions as an independent and accountable judicial branch agency.

II. IMPLEMENTATION AUTHORITY

Implementation of this policy shall be the responsibility of the Program Administrator.

III. EXECUTIVE LIMITATIONS

In carrying out this implementation authority, the Program Administrator shall consult with the Board.
